

**2012 IWLA Technology Workshop**

Thank you for your interest in the IWLA Technology Workshop!

The Urban Campus of DMACC is a few blocks north of our conference hotel. The easiest ways to get there are to take 6<sup>th</sup> Street or 9<sup>th</sup> Street to the north from the hotel. The campus is located just north of I-235 and one block west of Mercy Hospital and across the street to the west from the Downtown Holiday Inn.

If you take **6<sup>th</sup> Street**—

- Go north on 6<sup>th</sup> street and over I-235. It is one way heading north, so you should be prepared to get in the left lane by the time you cross over I-235. Just past the Downtown Holiday Inn, turn LEFT on Laurel. The next street is 7<sup>th</sup> Street and the DMACC Campus is right in front of you. Go STRAIGHT and as you enter the parking lot, Building 1 (where all the workshops will be held) is on your right. There are parking lots on the north and south sides of the building.

If you take **9<sup>th</sup> Street**—

- Go north on 9<sup>th</sup> street and just after crossing over I-235, take a RIGHT on Day. This street is JUST PAST the bridge over I-235. Then take a LEFT onto the campus. You will first see Building 2 on your right side. If you continue straight, you will then see Building 1 on your right side. Feel free to park in this first lot that is just south of Building 1 or continue straight and park in the lot north of Building 1.

Once you enter the building, all workshops are on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, on the north (away from I-235) side of the building. (Parking on the north side of the building may be the most convenient.) There is an elevator closest to the south entrance. There are stairs easily accessible from either the north or south entrance of the building. Vending machines are located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor, but there are restrooms on both the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors.
