

## Directions:

1. Divide the class into two teams. You can give each team a name if you want; the students seem to like doing that.
2. Teacher says a vocabulary word (the English meaning) to the first team. Any student from that team can stand p whether they know what the word is no not.
3. The opposing team then gets to decide together on a student who they think doesn't know the answer and call on that person to say the answer (the Spanish vocabulary word that the teacher said).
4. If the student the opposing team called on doesn't know the correct answer then you subtract the number of students standing on the team from their total points.
5. If the student does know the answer then the amount of points added to the team's score is the number of students standing.
6. The team at the end who has the most points gets extra credit on the next quiz or test.
